

In response to recommendation of National Election Committee in letter to him dated May 19, General Dean as Military Governor issued order for new election on June 23 in two of three districts of Cheju Island as follows:

"One. The elections in electoral district A and electoral district B of North Cheju Do held on May 10, 1948, under the law for the election of representatives for the Korean people issued March 17, 1948, are hereby declared null and void and of no effect.

Two. It is hereby ordered that a new election take place in these two districts on June 23, 1948 in accordance with Section 44 of the aforesaid law under the provisions of said law and under the supervision and control of the National Election Committee.

Three. This decision to nullify these elections was arrived at after consultation with the National Election Committee which took into consideration the fact that voting was held in less than 50% of the voting districts of electoral district A and electoral district B of North Cheju Do on May 10, 1948, due to activities and violence subversive elements. Under these circumstances the election in electoral district A and electoral district B of North Cheju Do on May 10, 1948, cannot be considered a true expression of the will of the people."

SIR:

With reference to paragraph 7 of Seoul POLAD telegram No. 386, May 25, 1948, I have the honor to enclose a list of the successful candidates in the Korean election of May 10, 1948, with pertinent data concerning each, as sent officially by the National Election Committee to Major General William F. DEAN, Military Governor, under date of May 21, 1948.

This list contains the names of only 198 successful candidates as a new election (Seoul POLAD Telegram No. 389, May 26, 1948) has been ordered in two of the three districts on Cheju Island.

For certain breakdown of these candidates into various categories, see Seoul POLAD telegram No. 384, May 22, and No. 390, May 26, 1948. The breakdowns in Seoul Polad telegram No. 384, May 22, were calculated on a full 200 successful candidates, thus including the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes in the two districts of Cheju Island where new elections have been ordered because slightly less than half of the registered voters were able to cast ballots because of disorders and subversive activities. One of these was a follower of Syngman Rhee and the other a Dai Dong Youth candidate.

There is also enclosed a list showing the breakdown by party affiliations of successful candidates by provinces, which includes the two candidates who will have to run over again on Cheju Island.
