

(1) At approximately 132400 May, 309 raiders attacked the village of HAMDOK (986-1155). One policeman was killed, five policemen were missing and two civilians were killed. One policeman and a bus driver were wounded when a raider threw a hand grenade into a passing bus. During the attack the police station was burned to the ground. (MG Report B-2)

(2) At 140700 May at CHEJU RI (923-1128) a police box was burned to the ground. No known casualties resulted. (MG Report B-2)

(3) At 140400 May 200 raiders attacked the village of HALLIM (934-1138). The wife of the Myun head was killed, one man was stabbed and six houses were burned. (MG Report, Police Report).

e. Raiders Attack CHEJU-DO Village

Three groups of raiders attacked different parts of the village of HALLIM (934-1138) at 141300 May, but were driven off by combined police and constabulary action. Five of the raiders were killed. Groups of raiders again attacked the village at 151500 May, killing one policeman and starting several fires. (MG Rpt B-2)
