f. Police Repell Raiders on CHEJU DO

During a search of the village of TOTO RI (946-1151) the police encountered 30 raiders. In the fight that followed two raiders were wounded and two were captured. The police confiscated three Japanese rifles, one stick of dynamite and communications equipment. (MG Report. B-2)

✓ f. Villages Raided on CHEJU-DO

(1) On 23 May, 50 raiders attacked the police in KOSAN NI (917-1126). Three of the raiders were killed. (MG Report. B-2)

(2) Raiders entered TOTO RI at 190300 May and kidnapped seven women and three men. One of the women was severely beaten and left for dead and four other women are believed killed, but their bodies have not been found. (CIC P/R #122. C-3)

✓ g. Constabularymen Desert on CHEJU-DO

(1) On 21 May, 41 constabularymen from MOSUL PO (925-1115) 11 of whom were non-commissioned officers, deserted with their weapons, equipment and 5600 rounds of ammunition. At 210400 May, 30 of these deserters attacked the police box at TAEJONG (926-1120), killed three policemen and one houseboy and wounded and kidnapped the police chief. (CIC P/R #122. B-2)

(2) Three officers of the 5th Korean Constabulary Regiment on CHEJU-DO are believed to have deserted and is believed to be result of the removal of the battalion commander for inefficiency. (Korean Constabulary Report)

✓ h. Constabulary Operations on CHEJU-DO

During the period 141800 May to 211800 May the Constabulary operated between SONG DANG NI (971-1147) and KYORAE-RI (967-1142) searching caves and rounding up guerrilla forces in that area. Seven guerrillas were killed and 200 prisoners taken. (G-3 O/P #23. B-2)

3. CIVIL UNREST

✓ a. Rioters Activities on CHEJU-DO

(1) At 202100 May the village of PUSON (983-1129) was attacked by an estimated 100 raiders, but the attackers were driven off by the police. (MG Rpt. B-2)

(2) At 210800 May five raiders, three armed, attacked the village of PYOSON (984-1129). One civilian and four raiders were killed but there were no police casualties. (MG Report. B-2)

(3) At 211600 May four raiders were killed and one was captured at O-DUNG NI (950-1146). One policeman was wounded. (MG Rpt. B-2)

(4) At 210400 May four raiders were killed by the police in the village of HAGWI RI (940-1149). (MG Report. B-2)

(5) Police patrols in the vicinity of (937-1139) captured seven suspicious persons on 23 May. (MG Report. B-2)

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3. CIVIL UNREST

✓ a. Correction of P/R #842

Later information reveals the report that three Constabulary Officers on CHEJU-DO deserted (See Par 3g(2), P/R #842) is incorrect. These officers departed for the mainland under orders.

✓ b. CHEJU-DO Riots

(1) On 23 May the police station at ANTOK Myun (966-1122) was attacked by raiders of unknown strength. One policeman was wounded and telephone lines were cut. (MG Rpt. B-2)

(2) At 230300 May the village of TOSAN NI (943-1120) was attacked by 30 raiders. One civilian, one Community Protective Corps member and 15 raiders were killed and one DAI DONG YOUTH member was kidnapped. (MG Rpt. B-2)

(3) At 192400 May an undetermined number of raiders murdered five persons, all members of policeman's families, at YONG DONG (near MOSULPO). (CIC P/R #125. Police Report)

(4) On 23 May a Korean was arrested in SUX O HO (953-1143) for attempting to recruit members for raiding groups. (MG Rpt. B-2)

✓ c. Constabulary Deserters on CHEJU-DO Apprehended

On 22 May 20 Constabularymen of the original 41 deserters on CHEJU-DO, were apprehended near TAE JONG (926-1120). 19 rifles and 3500 rounds of ammunition were recovered (MG Rpt B-2)
