d. Communications Severed on CHEJU-DO (Delayed Report)

During the night of 20 May telephone lines were cut in the village of WIMI (964-1123). No attempt to raid the village was made after the communications had been severed. (CIC P/R #126. Police Report)

3. CIVIL UNREST

a. Rightist Killed in KANGWON-DO

At 271600 May a rightist was attacked and killed by a mob of 20 communists near TONG EONG-NI (1177.0-1620.5). (7th Div Flash Rpt. D-3)

✓ b. Police Kill Raiders on CHEJU-DO

On 27 May a police platoon located an undetermined number of raiders in the vicinity of SAKI RI (916.0-1120.5) and killed five of the raiders. (MG Report. Police Report)

✓ c. Handbills Distributed on CHEJU-DO

(1) On 27 May inflammatory handbills were distributed in the Agricultural School on CHEJU-DO.

NOTE: This is the same school at which an attempt was made to murder a student on 25 May (See P/R #845). Constabulary arms and ammunition are stored within the dormitory where the murder was attempted and the handbills were distributed. (MG Report. B-2)

(2) On 26 May handbills advocating a school strike were distributed at the CHEJU-DO Industrial School. These handbills were signed by persons calling themselves the "People's Self-Sacrificing Organization" and promised punishment for all who disobeyed the strike order. (MG Report. B-2)

✓ d. Raider Organization on CHEJU-DO Revealed

A captured raider gave the following information as to the organization of raider units on CHEJU-DO. He stated that the raiders called themselves the "Mobile Combat Army" (YOO KYUK TAE) and that the groups consisted of about thirty men organized into seven man squads, each capable of individual action. The prisoner was told by his leaders that the largest raider unit was of regimental size and that training consists of lectures on communism and government. (MG Report. F-6)

5. Constabulary Capture Prisoners on CHEJU-DO

Since the beginning of the constabulary action on 30 May, 70 prisoners have been reported taken to date. Thirty of these have confessed membership in raider groups. The constabulary confiscated one M1 rifle, one Jap rifle, 3 spears and 2 bayonets from the prisoners. (MG Report. B-2)

K. Communists to Secure Data On CHEJU-DO Personnel

It is reported that members of the Liaison Section of the SOUTH KOREA LABOR PARTY in CHUNGCHONG-NAIDO have been ordered to compile data on all policemen, constabularymen and members of the NORTHWEST YOUNG MEN'S ASSOCIATION who have been or are being sent to CHEJU-DO. (CIC T/R #122. B-3)

a. Police Captures Load of Dynamite Enroute to CHEJU DO

During the 24 hour period ending 011800 June the CHEJU-DO (929-1206) police seized a boat carrying dynamite from PUSAN to CHEJU DO. (MG Report. B-2)

b. Peoples Liberation Army Organize on CHEJU-DO

A prisoner interrogated on CHEJU-DO stated that the raider groups had been reorganized into the 5th Regiment of the People's Liberation Army, commanded by a KIM Tal Sam. (MG Report)

b. Attack Repulsed on CHEJU-DO

At 020030 June raiders attacked the village of CHOCHUNG MI (coordinates unknown) from three directions, but the attack was repulsed by Constabularymen with no casualties to either force. (MG Report - B-2)
