

CHEJU DO null and void because voting was held in less than 50 per cent of the voting districts of these two electoral districts due to activities and violence of subversive elements. Simultaneously I ordered that a new election take place in these two electoral districts on 23 June 1948.

In view of the continuing efforts of subversive elements to disturb public peace and order on CHEJU DO Island, motivated by the desire to guarantee to the voting population of Electoral District A and Electoral District B of North CHEJU DO a peaceful and undisturbed election which truly represents the will of the people of these districts, I herewith order that the by-election in these two electoral districts is postponed for an indefinite period."

3. CIVIL UNREST

✓ a. Police Raid CHEJU-DO Village

Between 110300 and 110900 June 50 police raided TOTU RI (945-1151). 11 rioters were arrested, one was killed and the police confiscated dynamite detonators, signal flares, communist books and a press and necessary paper for printing handbills. (MG Report. B-2)

✓ b. Rightist Killed On CHEJU-DO

On 10 June 10 raiders armed with Japanese rifles killed the UNITED YOUNG MEN'S PARTY member at TOSUN RI (546-1220). (MG Report. B-2)

b. Village Raided On CHEJU DO

At 120900 June eight raiders entered the village of TORYOK RI (956-1151) and kidnapped six persons. (MG Report B-2)

c. Constabulary Captures Raiders On CHEJU DO

On 12 June constabulary troops captured 45 natives, three of whom were key men of raider groups. (MG report B-2)

a. Raidor Supply Point Found on CHEJU-DO

On 14 June constabulary troops discovered a raider supply point near the village of OSUNGSABENG AK (948-1137). Material confiscated included five Japanese swords, four bayonets, tentage, one mimeograph machine and 550,000 won. (MG report B-2)

✓ e. Constabulary Action on CHEJU-DO

Recent Constabulary action in the round up of raiders on CHEJU-DO resulted in four raiders being killed and 53 prisoners being captured. In this action the Constabulary also confiscated approximately two tons of miscellaneous supplies. (MG Report. B-2)

✓ f. CHEJU-DO Constabulary Commander Assassinated

PAK Chin Kyung, Commanding Officer of the 11th Constabulary Regiment on CHEJU-DO, was murdered while asleep at 180315 Junc. (MG Report. A-1)

COMMENT: Colonel PAK was rated one of the finest commanders and combat leaders in KOREA.

g. Advance Guard of North Korean People's Army Dispatched to CHEJU-DO

Approximately 160 persons armed with weapons and other supplies, members of KIM Il Sung's advance guard, have reportedly been dispatched from CHINNAMPO (840-1780) to proceed to CHEJU-DO. The mission of this group is to create dissension within youth organizations and particularly within the South Korean Constabulary and Coast Guard and to enlist the Rebels into the People's Army.
