c. Constabulary Actions On CHEJU-DO

During the 24 hour period ending 281800 June the constabulary captured 7 suspected raiders in the vicinity of KUM AK (949-1143) and apprehended 9 AMOL constabularymen in the vicinity of CHECHON RI (964-1156). During the same period 37 prisoners were turned over to the police for prosecution by the Korean courts. (MG Report. B-2)

c. Police Uncover Raider Supply Cache In CHEJU-DO

On 29 June the police on CHEJU-DO recaptured two Korean Constabularymen who had previously been captured and held prisoner by raiders. One of the constabularymen led patrols to a raider supply cache in the vicinity of SONGSANG-AK (948-1138) where the patrols confiscated 5 rifles, 11 hand grenades, 6 plastic Japanese anti-tank mines, 17 rounds of howitzer ammunition, 800 rounds of M1 rifle ammunition, 4 police uniforms, several helmets, swords and cooking equipment. b. Assassins of CHEJU-DO Constabulary Commander Apprehended

It is reported that all persons involved in the assassination of Colonel PAK Chin Kyung, former commander of the 11th Constabulary Regiment, have been apprehended and are awaiting interrogation and trial. (CIC P/R 155 A-1)

(5) Police Killed On CHEJU-DO (Delayed Report)

On 16 June two policemen, aboard a boat off the CHEJU-DO coast near PUSCHON-NI (969-1156) were killed when fired on by approximately 30 raiders. Four other occupants of the boat were kidnapped and taken to TAEHUI RI (965-1148) where they were released. (CIC P/R #155 C-3)

(6) CHEJU-DO Village Leader Killed

On 02 July the village leader of IL KWA RI, 1 kilometer northwest of MOSULPO (924-1116), was killed by a raider group. The raiders were reportedly the same group which was joined by 11 constabularymen after their desertion 02 July. (MG Report. B-2)
