On 14 September the CHEJU-DO Police arrested 13 persons in DO-YUN-RI (957 - 1148) suspected of raider activities. On 12 September 45 persons in CHUNGMUN Myun (940 - 1120) were arrested for furnishing food to raider groups. (CIC P/R #218. C-2)

(1) CHEJU-DO Raider Leader To Go To North KOREA

KIM Tai San, CHEJU-DO leader of the People's Liberation Army who recently returned from North KOREA, reportedly is going north again. (C-2) The alleged purpose of this latest trip is to receive the weapons and supplies which he arranged for during his previous visit to North KOREA. (CIC P/R #219. C-5)

a. Communist Terrorism

(1) Armed Band Terrorizes Village In CHOLLA-NAMDO

At approximately 161800 September 32 armed terrorists entered MOU-DUK Myun (1020-1325). They fired 10 shots into the air, apprehended the village master and forced him to guide them to the home of an influential person in the village. The armed mob stayed in the village until 182000 September and prevented all the civilians from leaving the village. Witnesses stated that the mob was armed with 4 carbines, 3 pistols, 1 Japanese rifle and 24 swords. (CIC P/R #225. C-3)

(2) Raider Activities On CHEJU-DO

During the period 15-18 September raider groups again became active on CHEJU DO, 4 persons having been killed by raider groups in various locations throughout the island. On 18 September approximately 12 people of SUH KWANG LI (930-1124) were abducted by a raider group but were released the following day. The kidnapping was apparently carried out to increase the prestige or indicate the power of the raiders.

On 18 September approximately 30 people in the village of HAM DOX LI (936-1155) were mobilized to set signal fires by a raider group.

On 17 September the KEUM YUNG (975-1157) police box was fired on by raiders but no damage was caused. (CIC P/R #225. C-2)

✓ (1) Handbills Distributed in South KOREA

The appearance of handbills in ANJOL Myun (940-1140), CHEJU-DO, has recently become a nightly occurrence. The following activities are advocated by the handbills.

- (1) Rid CHEJU-DO of the mainland police.
- (2) Support the People's Conference of the Korean Democratic People's Republic.
- (3) Destroy the separate government of KOREA, Syng Man.
- (4) Resist taxes and grain collection.

One handbill warned the police, NORTH KOREA, KOREA MEN'S ASSOCIATION and the Village Self Protection Police they should cooperate with the North Korean Republic because the American troops would soon leave. (CIC P/R #227. C-2)

Youth Organization Headquarters Raided on CHEJU-DO

On 22 September the police raided the headquarters of the NORTH WEST YOUNG MEN'S ASSOCIATION on CHEJU-DO, arrested the acting chairman of the organization and confiscated a carbine and a Japanese rifle. (A-1) The weapons were allegedly obtained by the NWYMA members when raiders
