a. Communist Terrorism

Raider Activities on CHEJU-DO

On 06 October 20 CHEJU-DO policemen engaged in a firefight with 40 armed raiders in the vicinity of KUMNYONG (975-1157). One policeman was wounded. (CIC Flash Report. C-2)

During Constabulary operations in the southern portion of CHEJU-DO on 06 October one battalion made contact with approximately 40 armed raiders in the vicinity of CHANG DAL LI (940-1122). In the firefight which developed 1 Constabularyman was killed and 4 were wounded. Raider casualties are unknown. (CIC Flash Report. C-2)

b. Submarine Sighted off CHEJU-DO

On 08 October an unidentified submarine was sighted off the coast of CHEJU-DO, approximately 10 miles north of CHEJU City. The submarine was flying a white flag on which was a red star. (Kimpo Report. A-1)

Raiders Arrested on CHEJU-DO (Delayed Report)

During recent operations on CHEJU-DO the constabulary arrested 800 persons. These prisoners are being screened to determine if any are connected with the CHEJU-DO People's Army. (CIC P/R #238. B-2)

b. Raider Terrorism and Attacks on CHEJU-DO

(1) At 230445 October raiders fired approximately 100 rounds at CHEJU CITY (962-1153) and the police box located on the East side of the town. No damages resulted. (CIC Flash Report. A-2)

(2) At 230730 October a constabulary jeep, containing the executive officer and 4 enlisted men of the 9th Regiment, Korean Constabulary, was ambushed by raiders on road west of CHUCHUN-LI (965-1155). The executive officer and 2 enlisted men were wounded. (CIC Flash Report. A-2)

(3) Air reconnaissance reported approximately 50 signal fires observed on North side of CHEJU-DO at 231800 October. (Radio Intercept)

(4) At 232000 October, the constabulary fired 40 rounds of 81mm mortar into a wooded area Southeast of CHEJU CITY (962-1153). (A-1) During the mortar firing, raiders fired approximately 30 rounds into the constabulary compound in CHEJU CITY. (CIC Flash Report. A-2)

(5) At 240700 October air reconnaissance reported many scattered mass meetings being held in villages. North Korean flags were displayed. (Radio Intercept).

✓ b. Raider Activities on CHEJU-DO

Raider activities on CHEJU DO continued during the period from 23 October to 27 October. Constabularymen captured approximately 50 demonstrators at MOSULPO (925-1115) and HALLIM-LI (925-1140) who were agitating school children with communist propaganda. (A-2)

During the past three nights the town of SOGWI (957-1120) was fired into and the blocking of roads and the cutting of telephone lines and poles by raiders has continued. (A-2)

On 24 October raiders attacked a constabulary and civilian wood gathering detail near CHEJU CITY (950-1152). One constabularyman was wounded and one civilian was killed and one wounded. (A-2)

On 25 October a bus was fired on by unknown persons on the main road in AEWOL Myun (930-1147). One person was killed and 1 wounded. (B-2)

✓ a. Raider Activities On CHEJU-DO

On 28 October 25 to 30 raiders attacked the SARYUNG (958-1155) police box. Japanese hand grenades and gasoline grenades were used by the raiders during the attack. Three policemen were killed, 3 raiders were killed and 5 policemen were wounded. (CIC Flash Report. B-2)

At about 272000 October a constabulary unit returning to CHEJU City surprised an unknown number of raiders building a roadblock at (951-1132). Fire was exchanged without reported casualties to either side. (CIC Flash Report. A-2)
