c. Raider Activities on CHEJU DO

On 23 October an estimated 60 raiders attacked the police at CHU CHUN NI (963-1154). Constabularymen arrived and the raiders were driven off. There were no casualties to either sides. (CIC P/R #254. C-3)

On 24 October 7 policemen repairing telephone lines near SHIN HEUNG NI (962-1154) were attacked by 40 raiders. One policeman was killed and his weapon was taken. Members of the NORTHWEST YOUNG MEN'S ASSOCIATION, acting as temporary policemen, were dispatched to the scene and drove off the raiders. (CIC P/R #254. C-3)

On 24 October 35 armed raiders and an unknown number of unarmed raiders attacked the police at SUO HUNG NI (938-1146). One policeman was killed and 1 was wounded. (CIC P/R #254. C-3)

On 29 October a Constabulary patrol surprised an estimated 200 raiders who were holding a meeting at KUHUNG NI (971-1146). A fight, which lasted about eight hours, developed between the raiders and the Constabulary patrol. The patrol was later reinforced by 2 Constabulary companies. Four raiders were killed and 20 were captured. The second in command, under KIM Tal San, of the CHEJU DO guerrilla forces was reported killed. Ammunition, weapons and clothing were confiscated from the raiders. Captured documents indicated that a 6-day campaign against CHEJU City was being planned by the raiders. No casualties to the Constabulary were reported. (CIC Flash Report. A-2)

Raider Activities on CHEJU-DO

On 27 October raiders attacked the JEMOL NI (931-1140) police box. Two policemen were killed and 4 were wounded. (CIC P/R #256. A-2) On the same day unknown persons threw a hand grenade at the tax office in CHEJU City. No damage or injuries resulted. (CIC P/R #256. A-1)

On 28 October constabularymen engaged approximately 40 raiders in a firefight at DODO NI (946-1150). Two raiders were killed. (CIC P/R #256. A-2)

On the night of 28 October raiders assassinated the father of a policeman in SUO HUNG NI (928-1124). On the same night 3 relatives of a police sergeant at SIN HUNG NI (964-1156) were assassinated by raiders. (CIC P/R #256. C-3)

On 29 October Constabulary action against raiders in the vicinity of KOSONG NI, ADEL Myun (930-1140) resulted in many casualties to raiders, including approximately 135 raiders killed. (CIC Flash Report. B-2)

A plot to assassinate staff members of the police and government officials and to begin riots and disorders in an attempt to establish a People's Republic of CHEJU D. was discovered at 010400 November, 30 minutes prior to the time guerrilla forces were to begin their activities. Seventy-five persons involved in the proposed plot were arrested including several members of the police. (CIC Flash Report. A-2)

✓ f. Rebel Leader Killed on CHEJU-D. Identified

The guerrilla leader killed on CHEJU-D. on 29 October, reported in P/R #977, has been positively identified as LEE Duk Son, second in command of the CHEJU-D. guerrilla forces. (CIC P/R #258. A-1)

✓ g. Communist Killed on CHEJU-D.

On 03 November the bodies of 7 civilians were discovered in CHEJU City (952-1152). The victims are reported to have been known communists in CHEJU City. (CIC P/R #258. A-2)

c. Raider Activities on CHEJU-D.

On 04 November a motorized police patrol was ambushed between CHEJU City (952-1152) and HANBOK NI (954-1152) by an unknown number of raiders. No casualties were reported. (A-1)

On 04 November 14 prisoners of the Constabulary in CHEJU City (952-1152) overpowered their guards and escaped, stealing 1 carbine. Six of the prisoners were recaptured and the carbine was recovered. A round-up of non-residents and unemployed persons is under way in CHEJU City in an effort to recapture all the escaped prisoners and to arrest all persons who may be connected with the CHEJU D. disturbances. Two constabularymen were found dead in CHEJU City on 05 November. (A-2)

On 05 November 500 raiders reportedly attacked and burned the police box and approximately 75 houses in CHUNG EUI NI (941-1120). Air observation revealed that approximately 40 buildings were destroyed by fire. (CIC Flash Report. A-2)
