(2) G-3 USAFIK reports that during the period 23-30 August, patrolling destroyers of the 7th Fleet apprehended four ships, transporting approximately 175 Koreans immigrating illegally to JAPAN, off CHEJU ISLAND. These ships have been impounded by Military Government.
