

NOTES ON INFORMATION OF POLICE BUREAU - 15 Oct 1946

Chechon, 8 Oct

Police billet set afire. 100,000 ¥ damage.

Chung Ju, 14 Oct

Hand grenade thrown at cousin of Korean Mayor at his home in Chung Ju.

Sanchong, 14 Oct

Rioters killed daughter of police sargant here.

Hadong, 8 Oct

100 leftists attacked police sta at 2330. 40-50 members of various organizations raided police box. They took one rifle, kidnapped one policeman and three right wing people. 16 arrests were made.

Hadong, 14 Oct

Rioters attacked police, destroyed homes of 3 right wing leaders. 4 rioters killed.

Cholla Namdo, 10 Oct

Bus strike - one arrest. 12 Oct - Labor leader accidentally shot and killed by police at Mung Ju. 300 miners came to view the body before cremation.

Che Ju Do Island

Riots reported. Tactical troops dispatched from Yo Su.

Chon Ju, 6 Oct

9 rioters killed, 12 rioters injured, 1 Policeman killed, 2 policemen injured.

Hyopch'on, 13 Oct.

Mob of terrorists reported active.

Koryong

Police kill 3 and wound 3 in riot.

Ulsan

300 rioters dispersed, 0200, 11 Oct. No casualties.

Tongnaw - 10 Oct 46

20 poliee disperse 200 rioters, 1 rioter killed, 40 arrests made.

Choong Chung Pukto, 10 ~~11~~ Oct

Curfew established

Chonan - strikers dispersed.

Yechon - Song Ju - Kunchon

Disorder expected - Reinforcements sent in to prevent it.

Taejon, 11 Oct - 1 agitator arrested.

Chonan

18 arrested for distributing handbills. Strikers dispersed.

PRESS CONFERENCE \* GENERAL LERCH \* 17 Aug 1946

5th Korean: Mentioned General Arnold's statement of yesterday concerning the growing idea among minorities that Korean politicians can establish an independent Korean government.

Gen. Lerch: Concurred with Gen Arnold's opinion. Gen Arnold doesn't want to judge Koreans by the acts of a few foolish people. Therefore, we are asking the people, politicians, and papers to discourage the idea of setting up a government outside the Moscow Decisions.
