An operation of that nature in view of the distance involved and the rugged nature of the terrain could be expected to last a month, but it should be effective.

b. Security Force Operation Against Rebels on CHEJU-DO

The 2nd Regiment of the Korean Army, supported by police, attacked a rebel hide-out at SONGPAN-AK (950-1130) on 6 April. Three rebels were killed, and 24 rebels were captured. The security forces confiscated the following materials:

3 M-1 rifles
5 Carbines
22 Japanese rifles
4,000 empty Japanese rifle shell cases. (C-2)

COMMENT: The capture of the empty shell cases supports a previous report (Incl #1, P/R #1097) that rebels have facilities for re-loading ammunition for Japanese rifles.
