

Korean Army Headquarters on 10 June announced that LEE Duk Koo, military leader of the armed rebels on CHEJU Island, (P/R 1097) had been killed in an action by troops of the 2nd Regiment on 7 June. (C-3)
A police report states that KIM Tae Chin, the second in command of rebels on CHEJU Island, was killed on 10 June by police. (C-3)

SUMMARY OF INCIDENTS IN 6th AND 8th DIVISION ZONES

(ODAX SAN AREA)

On 220200 March, elements of the 8th Division engaged a group of 80 guerrillas, moving northward toward the parallel, in the vicinity of CHIOK SAN (1170-1610) east of WONJU. As a result of this engagement, a total of 54 guerrillas were killed and 6 captured. Korean Army reports indicate that KIM TAL SAN, guerrilla leader, was killed in this engagement; however, this report has never been verified. Friendly losses: 4 KIA, 4 WIA.
