2. Non-Operational Intelligence.

a. Order of Battle for all Japanese forces in Southern KOREA.

(1) Documents submitted by the Japanese 17th Area Army located a total of 179,720 Jap troops in KOREA, south of 38° north latitude, when Allied forces landed. The total strength, not including naval troops, was further broken down into divisional districts:

c. Progress of Demobilization.

(5) The Japanese 17th Army has food supplies for two months' subsistence. The garrison at SUISSU has a six months' supply of f. d. Seventeen warehouses of foodstuffs and clothing have been located at SUISSU (990-1645). These have been placed under guard.
