WORK OF OBSERVATION GROUP I

Observation Group I, consisting of representatives of Australia, China, El Salvador, France, India and the Philippine Republic, commenced its work on 5 April when it held a meeting with the Chairman and representatives of the Seoul City Election Committee. During the afternoon of 5 April the Group visited selected voting districts in several areas of the city in order to observe the conduct of registration.

On the 6, 7 and 8 April Group I visited Kaesong, Incheon and Chunchong respectively. In each of these places the Group met with the local Election Committees and made inquiries concerning the methods and results of registration. Members of the Group then visited voting districts selected by them and obtained useful information concerning the methods and progress of the registration of voters in the areas observed.

On Friday 9 April members of the Group left by plane for Cheju-Do in order to carry out similar observations in that area.
