- a. TAEGU (1157 - 1439) - At approximately 2200, 23 May 48, BAE, Ki Su, a block master of HAN CHUNG, was shot to death by a group of four men. Prior to the shooting, the four, impersonating policemen, lured BAE from his home into the front yard. (A-1)
- b. YONGCHON (1190 - 1452) - (Delayed) - At 2230, 20 May 48, a group of members of the Northwest Young Men's Association attacked the home of an enlisted man of the Korean Constabulary, an alleged Leftist, killed his father and beat his mother and sister. (C-2)

4. Summary of Intelligence in Adjacent Areas.

5. Miscellaneous.

MOSULPO (924 - 1116) - On 24 May 48, two platoons of Korean Constabulary captured twenty deserters in the vicinity of coordinates (924 - 1118). The twenty were part of the group of forty-one who had deserted their organization on 21 May 48. (G-2 P/R #946, dtd 22 May 48). Nineteen M-1 rifles and 5,000 rounds of ammunition were taken from the deserters. (B-2)
