1. All units of the Provisional Artillery School departed 19 Mar for Kangju bivouac area. Firing demonstration to be held 1 April. This represents a most outstanding achievement in the Korean Army; if the firing lives up to expected results, all the fire of 90 guns will be capable of being massed on a given target within a matter of minutes.

2. Many new Korean Field Manuals have been printed and distributed to field - including Rifle Regt, Combat Intell, hand and rifle grenade, HW Co Rifle Regt, AT Co Inf Regt, Scouting and Patrolling, etc.

3. Squad demonstrations: Attack, defense and patrolling have been completed for all Brig by 5th AGT. Platoon demonstrations now being conducted. 17 Mar, demonstrations held for 1st, 11th, 12th and 13th Regts.

4. 15 Mar, 23 supply accountable Off grad from 3 wk supply course. New class of 30 Off starts 21 Mar. Subjects include stock record procedure. AGV, G-4, well-planned with results.

5. 2 Off and 16 EM completed Red Cross course in first-aid; similar texts to American texts used. These individuals will teach a similar class of 200 men commencing 21 Mar.

6. Korean Cav will purchase 40 horses per month, not to exceed 200 total. In addition, 25 brood mares are being purchased and sent to Lyonju breeding farm. Horse Sgdn now has 70 horses and is undergoing basic trng.

7. Dissidents:

a. Subversives tried, period 1 Jan - 15 Mar:

Sentences ranged from 6 death, 9 life to 6 months' hard labor.

b. Amnesty program: Cheju Do, period 26 Feb to date: 2200 dissident Civ have turned in to Hq, 2nd Regt. Estimated that each day a sizeable number will be joining the program.

(b, Amnesty Program, continued:)

Honam: Period 1 Jan to date: SELF, 5785; Rebels, 52; Guerrillas, 1654; TOTAL 7481.

Chiri-San: Period current ops: G-3, KA reports 20,000 Civ have signed certificates pledging support of KA and SK Govt. Certificates have been received by Gen Chung's Task Force Hq.

North Korea: During period of this rpt, 1 Capt, 2 Lts, and 1 Pvt deserted NK Army and turned in to SK Army. Reason: dissatisfaction.

8. Operations

a. 38th: 5 minor border incidents during period. No casualties reported.

b. Yongwoh Area, new operations:

6th Brig now optg this area; Mission: locate and reduce any guerrilla bands or supply points encountered. Ops commenced 19 Mar; no results reported to date.

c. Chiri-San: 70 guerrillas KIA; 86 POW; 43 small arms recovered. KA Losses: 1 KIA and 1 MIA.

d. Honam: 24 guerrillas KIA; 18 POW. KA losses, 2 KIA and 1 MIA.

e. Kyungsoong Pukto Area, new operations:

In this area, there are reported approx 400 guerrillas, about 80 armed with rifles and remainder spear-men and unarmed. 3d Brig units presently optg in area. Current results: 4 guerrillas KIA; 81 POW. No friendly casualties reported.

f. Cheju Do: 58 guerrillas KIA; 27 POW. KA losses, 18 KIA and 4 MIA. 2 LMG, 9 M-1 and 2 Carb recovered.

9. KA Strength: 2909 Off; 64,376 EM; 1579 Cadets; TOTAL 68,864.

10. Reserve Corps. 1st class of Res Off Trng Schl graduated Sihung 16 Mar; 118 graduating out of 119. All to be commissioned 2nd Lt, Res Corps. Res strength: 118 Off; 12,536 EM. See atchd memo for complete recap of Res Corps, including future plans.

Navy vessel used to transport relief supplies to Cheju
Do. Main items consisted of shoes, 1800 yd cloth, 60 boxes multi-
purpose food (70 bls ea box) and 100 lb medicine.
