5. MISCELLANEOUS:

The following ships departed Pusan for MAKATA, KYUSHU, carrying repatriates to Japan: The TENYA MARU with 925 civilians at 0600, and the UNZEN MARU with 2020 civilians at 1400. LST's 657 and 754 departed from CHEJU ISLAND for SASEBO at 091500 with 2199 Jap POW's.

3. OPERATIONS FOR THE PERIOD:

a. 6th Inf Div:

The 2d Bn, 1st Inf, departed from ANDONG, by rail, for KUMCHON (1110-1469) at 0810. A Platoon of Co K, 1st Inf, arrived in YECHON (1142-1534) from SANGJU at 1800. A reconnaissance party from the 20th Inf left HANCHANG-RI (963-1260) for WADO Island (976-1249). Co E, 20th Inf, dispatched a patrol to KUNO-DA Island (1075-1275) where they found many depth charges, mine fuzes and an unarmed mine. The 80th FA Bn arrived in SACHON (1108-1343) at 1500. 569 Japanese civilians left KWANGJU, by rail, for FUSAN at 1730. The 6th Inf Div assumed responsibility for the control of CHEJU Island at 2400.
