3. OPERATIONS FOR THE PERIOD:

a. 6th Inf Div: A Btry, 80th FA Bn, displaced from CHINTU (1108-1355) to CHINHAE after being relieved by C Btry, 80th FA Bn. 40 additional cases of Cholera with 30 attributable deaths at PUSAN, 279 additional cases with 172 resultant deaths at TEGU, 17 additional cases with 1 death on CHEJU ISLAND, and 10 additional cases with 11 deaths at MOKPO (937-1308) were reported during this period. Units engaged in repairing routes of communication cut by flood.
