- (1) One composite rifle platoon 2d Battalion, 1st Infantry Regiment departed Pusan (1202-1345) by air on 061045 October 1948 closed Cheju-Do (951.0-1150.0) on 061555 October 1948.
- (2) One composite rifle platoon 2d Battalion, 1st Infantry Regiment departed Cheju-Do (951.0-1150.0) by air on 061635 October 1948 closed Pusan (1202-1345) on 061855 October 1948.
- (3) 1st Infantry Regiment conducted one Air Patrol for intelligence and security.

3. OPERATIONS FOR THE PERIOD

a. 6th Infantry Division:

- (2) One (1) composite rifle platoon, 2nd Battalion, 1st Infantry Regiment departed Camp Rees (1202-1345) 041130 November 1948 by air to Cheju-Do. Closed Cheju (950.2-1150.2) 041340 November 1948.
- (3) One (1) composite rifle platoon, 2nd Battalion, 1st Infantry Regiment departed Cheju (950.2-1150.2) 041450 November 1948, by air, closed Camp Rees (1202-1345) 041600 November 1948.
- (4) Battery "A", 1st Field Artillery Battalion conducted eight aerial patrols for intelligence and security.
- (5) A general alert was declared for the 1st Infantry Regiment, 021305 November 1948 in connection with the rioting within the 6th Korean Constabulary Regiment Camp adjacent to Camp Skipworth. Elements of 1st Infantry Regiment deployed to prevent passage of rioters through Camp Skipworth. A platoon of "A" Company, 1st Infantry Regiment was dispatched from

Camp Skipworth at 021330 November 1948 for reconnaissance and security in connection with the rioting, closed Camp Skipworth 021720 November 1948. Four (4) Officers, 303 enlisted men, Korean Constabulary and 12 Korean Civilians surrendered to the Commanding Officer, 1st Infantry Regiment. The rioters were then turned over to the Commanding Officer, 3d Constabulary Regiment at 030930 November 1948.

- (1) The 3d and 12th Regiments, Korean Constabulary, are continuing mop-up operations in the Chiri mountains.
- (2) 9th Regiment, Korean Constabulary, suppressing rioters on Cheju-Do.
- (3) (Delayed) For the period 21 October 1948 to 5th November 1948, 3,628 prisoners have been taken and 239 killed.
