- b. The following additional information regarding ship "ENESSEY" (reference G-2 Report #256, 1 July 46) was obtained: The ship was enroute from VLADIVOSTOK to port near DAIREN. Broken circulating system forced ship to anchor off CHEJU Island. Passengers are Russian civilians, women, children, and Navy and Army personnel. It was impossible to determine the total number of passengers aboard. Ship's capacity is estimated at 10,000 tons, with one smoke stack. Russian flag is flying on stern of ship. Ship believed to have radar equipment. On the morning of 3 July, a Russian destroyer, #3K-8, arrived off CHEJU Island to assist the ship "ENESSEY". 20th Infantry guard reported seeing two submarines on the morning of 3 July when destroyer first appeared. A search during the afternoon of 3 July by a U. S. C-47 failed to verify report of submarines.
