- b. The following additional information regarding ship "ENESSEY" (reference G-2 Report #256, 1 July 46) was obtained: The ship was enroute from VLADIVOSTOK to port near DAIREN. Broken circulating system forced ship to anchor off CHEJU Island. Passengers are Russian civilians, women, children, and Navy and Army personnel. It was impossible to determine the total number of passengers aboard. Ship's capacity is estimated at 10,000 tons, with one smoke stack. Russian flag is flying on stern of ship. Ship believed to have radar equipment. On the morning of 3 July, a Russian destroyer, #3K-8, arrived off CHEJU Island to assist the ship "ENESSEY". 20th Infantry guard reported seeing two submarines on the morning of 3 July when destroyer first appeared. A search during the afternoon of 3 July by a U. S. C-47 failed to verify report of submarines.

PROGRESS MADE IN TURNING OVER GOVERNMENTAL
FUNCTIONS TO KOREANS IN THE 6TH INF DIV ZONE

- a. CHOLLA-SOUTH: Such satisfactory progress has been made by Korean officials in assuming governmental duties in CHOLLA-SOUTH Province that Military Gov-

ernment has requested the deactivation of all MG Companies within the province. With the exception of the management of alien properties, and, to a certain extent, civil police activities which require further closer supervision, all government functions are now controlled by Korean officials. All communications for the transmission of orders to subordinate governmental agencies are now handled through Korean channels, and all decisions except major decisions are made by the Koreans themselves. The activities and personnel of MG Companies in MOKPO (938 - 1307), SUNCHON (1048 - 1327), and KWANGJU (991 - 1350) are gradually being reduced and absorbed by the 101st MG Group in KWANGJU. CHEJU Island, which is now controlled by the 59th MG Co under the control of the 101st MG Group, will become a separate province, effective 1 Aug 46, and will be under the supervision of a separate provincial group.

- a. The 59th MG Co on CHEJU Island reported by radio that a Russian ship, the "SERGO-ORD JIARKYAI D" (spelled as per copy) No 599, anchored one mile off the city of CHEJU (952 - 1152) at 0400, 20 July. MG officers went out to the ship and learned that the ship had left DAIREN 14 July enroute to TOYMAOKA KARA FUTO (spelled as per copy) and had run into a storm off the southern tip of Korea. The ship's captain, DIMITRI MAXIMO, said, that he had lost his food rations in the storm and requested that food supplies be furnished him. Officers agreed to supply him and took the ship's captain and the engineer officer ashore to obtain the food. Rice, salt, and canned meat in amounts requested were supplied. After taking on rations, the ship departed at 1200, 20 July. There were 38 passengers consisting of soldiers and civilian men and women in addition to a crew of 20 aboard. The ship's tonnage was given as 11,874 tons. The ship's captain requested that the Russian Commander at VLADIVOSTOK be informed.
