

areas for some time to maintain better liaison within the province. Although there has been some question raised as to whether CHEJU Island is sufficiently self-supporting to carry the added burden of an extensive provincial government, plans are being completed to separate the CHEJU government from CHOLLA-SOUTH and raise it to a provincial level, effective 1 Aug 46. The government of CHOLLA-SOUTH on the provincial level is still being supervised more closely than at lower levels, with MG officers in KWANGJU (991 - 1350) supervising and reporting on the following departments: Agriculture and Commerce, Property Custodian, Home Affairs, Public Health, Public Safety, Public Utilities, Education and the Korean Constabulary. Two other major departments, Finance and Public Works, are now under the complete supervision of Korean department heads.

- a. The U.S. Destroyer "NORRIS", during the period from 4 Sept to 12 Sept 46, apprehended and seized the following illegal shipping:
- (3) The JUNG POK HAN, D-758, three masted junk, was apprehended at 0900, 5 Sept 46, at latitude 34° 05' North, longitude 127° 28' East for not having registration papers and for carrying 30 illegal passengers to CHEJU Island. A Korean Coast Guard prize crew took her into MOKPO.
- (4) The PUK SU WHAN II, #112, 70 foot diesel lugger with 1 sail, was apprehended at 1000, 9 Sept 46, at latitude 33° 38.1' North, longitude 126° 55' East for not having registration papers and for carrying an illegal cargo of hardwood from Japan to CHEJU Island. A Korean Coast Guard prize crew took her into MOKPO.
- (5) The HON JANG WHAN, B-54, 55 foot power craft, was apprehended at 1445, 11 Sept 46, at latitude 33° 56' North, longitude 126° 29' East for carrying two illegal passengers and an illegal cargo of salt and soap to CHEJU Island. A Korean Coast Guard prize crew took her into MOKPO.
- (6) The KIM HIRA WHAN, 70 foot diesel lugger, was apprehended at 1100, 11 Sept 46, at latitude 33° 40.2' North, longitude 126° 38.2' East for not having registration papers and for carrying the following illegal cargo from CHEJU Island to MOKPO: 45 drums of oil, 84 cans of paint and 4 cases of clothing. A Korean Coast Guard prize crew took her into MOKPO.
- (7) The KIM BIERA WHAN, S-834, 35 foot diesel fishing craft, was apprehended at 1430, 9 Sept 46, at latitude 34° 12' North, longitude 127° 28' East for not having any registration papers and for carrying 3 illegal passengers and the following illegal cargo from CHEJU Island to PUSAN: 3 bags of sweet potatoes, 5 bags of corn, some chickens, several sewing machines and several bundles of shoes. A Korean Coast Guard prize crew took her into PUSAN.
