5. Miscellaneous.

- a. The U.S. Destroyer "BRUSH", during the period 11 Dec to 13 Dec 46, apprehended the following illegal shipping.

- (1) The HEUNJIN WHAN, 19 ton, 65 foot diesel, was apprehended at 0900, 12 Dec 46, at SUNGSANPO, CHEJU Island, for illegal cargo valued at 1,000,000 yen and carrying 38 passengers illegally from OSAKA, Japan to CHEJU, Korea. A Korean Coast Guard prize crew took her into MOKPO.
- (2) The KIMWALILANKI (Chinese vessel), 15 ton, gasoling power sailing junk, was apprehended at 0900, 12 Dec 46, at SUNGSANPO, CHEJU Island, for illegal port of entry, no cargo manifest for cargo, including large supply of penicillin, foodstuffs, cotton and woolen goods. A Korean Coast Guard prize crew took her into MOKPO.

4. Summary of Intelligence in Adjacent Areas.

- a. (EXTRACT: USAFIK G-2 Periodic Report #429, 14 January 1947):
"Legislative Notes -- Meeting on 13 January with seventy-one members present, *** Dr KIM, Kyu Sik, presiding chairman, read General Hodge's letter which disclosed the fact that the General has advised LYUH, Moon Iyung and CHANG, Kun Sang, Leftist appointees who have thus far declined their seats, that they must register with the Assembly before 15 January or lose their memberships. Also, the letter stated that the General has directed the governor of CHEJU DO to proceed with the election of two members to replace those Leftists from that province who previously had refused to take their seats."

Miscellaneous.

The U.S. Destroyer "HOLLISTER", DD788, during the period 2 Jan. to 17 Jan 47, apprehended and seized the following illegal shipping:

- a. The SHING WAN WHAN, P-9, small passenger boat, was apprehended at 1200, 3 Jan, at Latitude 34° North, Longitude 126° 25' East for having 5 bags of illegal rice aboard. A Korean Coast Guard prize crew took her into CHEJU (955 - 1150).
- b. The SANGU WHAN, M-318, motor junk, was apprehended at 1415, 4 Jan, at Latitude 33° 45' North, Longitude 126° 31' East, for carrying 8 illegal passengers and the following illegal cargo: tools, 500 gallons of gasoline,

salted fish and 3 trucks. A Korean Coast Guard prize crew took her into MOKPO (938 - 1307).

- c. The KIMBU JEAN, MM-65, motor cargo boat, was apprehended at 1125, 9 Jan, at Latitude 33° 53' North, Longitude 126° 28' East, for having 900 sacks (60 kilograms per sack) of illegal rice aboard. U.S. Navy personnel did not inventory cargo but believed that more than 900 sacks were aboard; authenticity of clearance papers also extremely doubtful. A Korean Coast Guard prize crew took her into MOKPO.
- d. The CHUN ILL-WEAN, D-673, 12 ton motor cargo boat, was apprehended at 1100, 13 Jan, at Latitude 33° 50' North, Longitude 126° 50' East, for having an illegal cargo of at least 50 bales of cotton aboard. A Korean Coast Guard prize crew took her into MOKPO.
- e. The CHONG KWONG WHANG, N-224, motor cargo boat with auxiliary sail, was apprehended at 1630, 15 Jan, at Latitude 33° 36' North, Longitude 126° 36' East, for having an illegal cargo of cotton, silk, and 20 sacks of rice. Destination was CHEJU Island but since the motor had broken down, the U.S. Destroyer "HOLLISTER" towed her to within 2 miles of shore and radioed the LSM 321 in the harbor to send out a launch and to turn boat over to U.S. Army at CHEJU.

✓ (1) (EXTRACT: USAFIK G-2 Periodic Report #445, 1 February 1947):

"General Youth's League For Acceleration of Korean Independence Requests Removal of Police Chief of CHEJU-DO - The CHEJU-DO branch of the 'Youth League For Acceleration of Korean Independence', in a letter to the Chief of Police Affairs Department, Military Government, requests the removal from office of the Chief of the CHEJU-DO police. The 'Youth League', accuses SIN, Woo Kyoan, Chief of the Inspection Office of the following: (1) Having night meetings with known Communists; (2) suppressing disclosures of Leftist offenses; (3) trafficking with profiteers; (4) increasing the power of the Communist organization."
