a. General Conditions.

Extract from PUSAN District CIC Report #253, 10 April 1947: "A delayed police report dated 1 April, indicates concerted activities on the part of Post Office (communications) personnel in MOKPO (938 - 1307), KWANGJU (991 - 1350) and PUSAN to obtain the release of telegraph operators arrested in CHEJU after the strike, by petitioning government authorities. YU Tae Hyun, a PUSAN telegraph inspector, received a message from 'Friends' in MOKPO And KWANGJU urging him to petition the Chief of Police, inspectors and investigation officers for the release of the above. Subsequently, YU sent telegrams to some twenty four cities in KYONGSANG-North, signed them in the name of the PUSAN operators, and asked those localities to petition government authorities concerning the release."

b. Cholla-South:

Extract from a CIC report of 12 June 1947: "strikes - On CHEJU Island (951 - 1149) on 2 June approximately 180 students of the 3rd year class of the CHEJU Girls' Middle School went on strike. Demands for the most part are levied against the principal and insist on (1) higher type courses, (2) a stop to fascist education, (3) ousting of fascist molecules in the school, and (4) a correction of the principals actions. No political significance has been noted as yet, however, the cry against fascist elements and domination sounds vaguely familiar carrying a 'red' undertone."

(EXTRACT: XXIV Corps, G-2 Summary #92, 15 June 1947):
"SONGSAN (990 - 1140) - 6 June 47, policemen in KUMHAYUN, two miles North of SONGSAN, were beaten and tied with wire while disbanding an illegal meeting of the 'South Korea Labor Party' which was being held on a tug at the seacoast. Those responsible have not been apprehended."

HANDOK (965 - 1155)(not on map) - At 1430, 13 August 47, approximately 200 Koreans attacked the police box at HANDOK on CHEJU Island. Two policemen were beaten and one woman in a garden was accidentally shot. Order was restored by Korean police reinforcements. Reason for the attack is unknown. No further details were available at close of period.
