CHEJU-DO:

CHEJU-DO (960 - 1140) - (Delayed) - During the period 3-4 April 48, a series of Leftist instigated raids on police boxes resulted in the deaths of four policemen, nine Rightists and three Leftist civilians. Additional casualties include five police wounded and sixteen Rightists injured. Three policemen and four Rightists are reported missing.

Six U.S. Carbines and one Jap rifle together with a total of 119 rounds of ammunition were captured by the raiders. (A-1)

CHEJU-DO:

a. E-HO-RI (946 - 1151) - (not on map) - At 0220, 6 April 48, two members of the United Young Men's Party were shot to death in their homes by a small raiding party of Leftists. (A-1)

b. PONGGAL-RI (960 - 1148) - Early on the morning of 6 April 48, a United Young Men's Party member was shot to death in his home by an unknown number of Leftists. (A-1)

CHEJU-DO (951 - 1152) - Police report that at 0500, 8 April 48, police reserves from KIANGJU (992 - 1350) armed with machine guns arrived at Han Kim Myun where they were attacked by an undetermined number of Leftists. One leftist was killed during the attack. (B-2)

SINM (949 - 1152) - (not on map) - During the night of 10 April 48, three Rightists were killed during a leftist raid on the town. (A-1)

HEIOL (948 - 1152) - (not on map) - On 10 April 48, one policeman and one Rightist civilian were wounded in an attack on a police sub-station. Additional details are being sought. (A-3)
