✓ a. General Conditions.

CHOCHON-NI (903 - 1154) - On 3 May 48, the entire election committee resigned stating as the reason that conditions were "too dangerous" for them to continue in their duties. (B-2)

b. Civil Disturbances by Province.

(1) Cneju-do:

(a) AETOL-NI (931 - 1146) - At 1330, 3 May 48, a group of approximately 100 men attacked the village where they were met by 36 Constabularymen and 17 policemen who opened fire. Additional details are being sought. (B-2)

✓ (b) WOLTAG-NI (958 - 1148) - (not on map) - (Delayed report) - At 2330, 30 April 48, a crowd of fifty men, several of whom were armed with carbines, entered the village and set fire to the homes of two members of the United Young Men's Party. (B-2)

MOSUIPO (924 - 1117) - On 4 May 48, a bundle of dynamite was tossed into a local police box. The explosive failed to detonate. (B-2)

a. Cneju-do:

✓ (1) HAMMUK (966 - 1155) - On 4 May 48, a group of fifty men attacked and kidnapped two members of the United Young Men's Party. (B-2)

(2) E-HO-RI (946 - 1151) - On 4 May 48, a group of policemen, engaged in repairing a telephone line were fired upon from a nearby ridge. Police returned the fire wounding one sniper who was later captured. (B-2)

CHANGJON-NI (938 - 1145) - (not on map) - At 1800, 7 May 48, firing between police and an armed group of unknown number resulted in the death of one policeman and the wounding of five others. No casualties to raiders were reported. (B-2)
