

c. Illegal Activity of a Subversive Nature.

- (11) Chungaun Myun (945 - 1123) - On 10 May 48, a polling booth was raided and all ballots were destroyed. (Police report)
 - (12) Songsan Myun (965 - 1143) - On 10 May 48, the voting booth was burned by a group of sixty men. (A-1)
 - (13) CHEJU-UP (952 - 1152) - On 10 May 48, two dynamite charges were exploded near the CHEJU City Hall. No casualties were reported. (A-1)

c. Cheju-DO:

- (1) CHEJU-DO AIRSTRIP (948 - 1150) - At 1140, 10 May 48, two groups of approximately 250 and 50 men respectively were engaged in a fire fight 200 yards south of the AIRSTRIP. The larger group was carrying plain white flags. A platoon of Constabulary was dispatched to the scene but the larger group had disappeared in the vicinity of coordinates (949 - 1144). No casualties were reported. (A-1)
- (2) Pyoson Myun (930 - 1130) - On 10 May 48, one polling place was raided. Two persons were killed and all ballots were destroyed. (Police report)
- (3) SONGDANG-NI (978 - 1147) - At 1100, 10 May 48, two persons were killed, one was wounded and seven houses burned. Details are being sought. (B-2)

c. Cheju-Do:

HAMBOK (942 - 1144) - At 1600, 11 May 48, a group of unknown persons captured two policemen and took them to the hills. (C-3)

5. Miscellaneous.

- b. CHOCHON-NI (963 - 1154) - On 10 May 48, the Constabulary killed one man, who attempted to escape while being held for questioning. (B-2)
- c. SINAM-NI (935 - 1147) - At 1300, 10 May 48, five Constabularymen were met by a Military Government Officer at a suburb of SINAM-NI. The Constabularymen stated that they had been driven out of SINAM-NI by a group of sixteen raiders. Later in the evening, investigation disclosed that no such incident had occurred, that no raiders were present in the town, and that the five Constabularymen had left their posts. The U.S. Advisor to this Constabulary reports that the men will be tried for deserting their posts. (A-1)

Civil Disturbances by Province.

a. Cheju-Do:

- (1) CHEJU-UP (951 - 1151) - On 11 May 48, the 20th Infantry Detachment was alerted twice, due to the appearance of a large group of persons south of the AIRSTRIP (948 - 1152), who were exchanging shots with people in the small village just west of the AIRSTRIP. At 1100, 12 May 48, the shooting was continuing. (A-1)
- (2) HIGWI-RI (940 - 1148) - On 12 May 48, a group of approximately 300 persons, fired on a police truck. Police killed two of the attackers who were armed with U.S. Carbines. (B-2)
- (3) At coordinates (943 - 1141) - Korean Constabularymen entered a village and took twenty-five prisoners, who had been armed with spears. Details are being sought. (B-2)
- (4) At coordinates (946 - 1145) Korean Constabularymen apprehended 193 persons, living in caves and tents. One of the prisoners agreed to take the Constabulary to "Rebel" Headquarters. The remainder are being held for questioning. (B-2)

a. Civil Disturbances by Province.

Cheju-Do:

- (1) HAMDONG-RI (966 - 1155) - police report that at 1600, 13 May 48, an estimated 300 men raided the town. Three houses and a police box were burned. One policeman was killed, one was wounded and five policemen are missing. A bystander was injured by police fire. The mother of a policeman was killed. A bus driver was wounded by a hand grenade thrown at his bus, while he was occupying it. (police report)
- (2) HALLA (923 - 1137) - Between 0400-0800, 14 May 48, a group of approximately 200 men, raided the town. The wife of the Myun Chief was shot and killed. One man was wounded by a knife wielded by one of the attackers. Six houses were set afire by the raiders, who then withdrew. At 1300, 14 May 48, a group of approximately 200 raiders again attacked the town. Five of the raiders were killed by Korean Constabulary and police in a coordinated action. No casualties were reported among police or the Constabulary. Identifi-
