Cheju-do:

- a. HAKWI-RI (940 - 1149) - On 18 June 48, the village was attacked by approximately twenty raiders. One of the raiders was killed. (Police report)
- b. MONNON-RI (916 - 1123) - (not on map) - At 1400, 19 June 48, a police box was attacked. No casualties were reported. (Police report)

b. Illegal Activity of a Subversive Nature.

✓ PUKCHON-RI (969 - 1156) - On 24 June 48, Korean Constabularymen captured nine prisoners in a cave in the village. Two of the prisoners admitted killing two policemen on 16 June 48. Several home-made grenades and a small amount of anti-police literature found in the cave were confiscated. (B-2)

CHEJU-DO: At 1710, 8 Oct 48, a submarine was sighted by the pilot of a U.S. Courier plane at 126° 48' E - 33° 56' N. The submarine flying a flag, bearing a star superimposed upon a red field, was proceeding East at a speed of 10-12 knots. The vessel, while not identified, was neither U.S. nor British. (B-3)
