a. CHEJU DO Situation:

6th Inf Div reported that on 8 May, Korean Constabulary units were to be used to protect polling places on CHEJU DO during elections, 10 May. Korean Constabulary are now engaged in the distribution of election ballots in many districts due to the failure of the election committee to assume the responsibility. (B-2)

4. SUMMARY OF INTELLIGENCE IN ADJACENT AREAS.

a. CHEJU-DO Re-Election Indefinitely Postponed: (XXIV)

On 10 June the Military Governor issued the following proclamation:

"By virtue of the power vested in me by Section 44, Law for the Election of Representatives of the Korean People, of 17 March 1948, acting on recommendation of the National Election Committee, I declared on 24 May 1948 the election held on 10 May 1948 in Electoral District A and Electoral District B of North CHEJU DO null and void because voting was held in less than 50 per cent of the voting districts of these two electoral districts due to activities and violence of subversive elements. Simultaneously I ordered that a new election take place in these two electoral districts on 23 June 1948.

In view of the continuing efforts of subversive elements to disturb public peace and order on CHEJU DO Island, motivated by the desire to guarantee to the voting population of Electoral District A and Electoral District B of North CHEJU DO a peaceful and undisturbed election which truly represents the will of the people of these districts, I herewith order that the by-election in these two electoral districts is postponed for an indefinite period."

c. Submarine Sighted Off CHEJU-DO:

Other Intelligence Sources reported that at 1210 hours, 8 October, a Cheju Do bound plane sighted an unidentified submarine approximately three (3) miles off Cheju Do Island. At 1230 hours, 8 October, on it's return flight to KIEPO, the same plane sighted the submarine approximately twenty-five (25) miles north of Cheju Do. According to the pilot of the plane, the submarine was flying a flag with a red star, and carried the number C-53. (B-1)
