

3. Cheju-Do Incident:

- a. 24 October 1949, an unknown number of armed guerrillas were engaged on the island of Cheju-Do. The following is the result of this action:

(1) Guerrilla Losses:

'a' K.L.: 3. (Including Kim Song Ok)

'b' Japanese Pistols: 1.

'c' Model 99 Rifles: 1.

'd' Blankets: 7.

'e' Rice: 4 Bags.

(2) Friendly Losses:

'a' Negative.

d. Miscellaneous:

- (1) 161315 November 1949, an unidentified ship, about 5,000 tons, was observed moving out to Cheju Do (950-1101) area about 10 miles southwest of Mosil Po (923-1116). (F-6)
- (2) 152000 November 1949, a Russian ship (about 2,000 tons) has reportedly appeared between Cheju Do and Yosu (1074-1301) and unknown number of arms and ammunitions were unloaded at Sam Chon Po area (1103-1326) Sachon Gun, Kyongsang "ando by a wooden boat and later carried to the Chi Ri San area. (F-6)

d. Miscellaneous:

- (1) 160115 November 1949, an alert is being conducted by South Korean Armed Forces on the coast line and sea of Cheju Do. for an unidentified 5,000 ton merchant ship: in an area 10 miles west of Mosul Po, Taechon, Kyon, South of Cheju Do and sailing with a speed of about 10 KPH. It is reportedly sailing towards Kaju direction, Japan. (C-3)

2. CURRENT INTELLIGENCE:

d. Miscellaneous:

- (1) 15 November 1949, three (3) unidentified ships (Russians?) were observed sailing towards Cheju Do (950-1150); then changed their course towards Samchon 10 area (1107-1324) where they anchored and landed an unknown number of equipment by small boats. They later sailed towards an unknown direction (F-6)

- (3) Thirty armed guerrillas and three hundred unarmed are reported on Cheju Do. This report further states that reinforcement of guerrillas from the mainland is expected during June and July. This report will be investigated. An inspection team composed of representatives from the Army, Navy, and Ministry of Home Affairs has been proposed to study condition of civil affairs. A marine battalion and national police now garrison the island.
