13. Delayed report from Chaju Do indicates healthy army activity, particularly in raids; systems in patrolling attacks and excellent cooperation with Police. Central Intelligence Agency working very well. Major Song, Regt 1 CO, strong and active. Activities noted:

28 October: 50 raiders attacked, repulsed. Police casualties, 4 Killed 5 wounded. At least 8 raiders killed.

28 October: Many stone road blocks erected.

28 October: 9th Regt 1 CO arrested 17 men of Regt (a cell).

29 October: Engagement KC vs Rebels, estimates of 100 to 135 raiders dead.

Present activities characterized by nuisance raids against police and Army, and not against civilians with organized forces having upper hand.

18. Lee Duk Ku, Red leader, killed 29 October, has been identified. Said to be Number 1 leader there at time of death.

9. Chaju Do: Report dated 12 November indicates as follows:

Considerable village burning; Village Wolpyong burned; 1st Bn CP attacked by 150. No casualties. 4 enemy dead; 2nd Bn, on info from loyal villagers,

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struck Rebel hideout - killed 18, captured 1. Later killed 4 others; "P" Co, 2nd Bn, captured raider storehouse near Hallim - 25 raiders killed, 3 captured; 3rd Bn assisting burned out villagers in another area with food and clothing; cooperation with Police excellent; Natives now giving info to constituted authorities; Central Intelligence Agency excellent; Plan to send 2 Co's to Cheju Do abandoned by Koreans. Now plan to recruit up to full strength all 3 Bns, mainly from NW Youth.
