50 guerrillas attacked by ambushing 2 Second Regiment trucks. 15 soldiers and 1 civilian driver killed. 150 Jap rifles and unknown quantity of ammunition taken.

American Ordnance Advisor returned from inspection of motor vehicles of 2d Regiment and recommended 100% replacement.
