

7. Dissidents:

a. Subversives tried, period 1 Jan - 15 Mar:

Sentences ranged from 6 death, 9 life to 6 months' hard labor.

b. Amnesty program: Cheju Do. period 26 Feb to date: 2200 dissident Civ have turned in to Hq, 2nd Regt. Estimated that each day a sizeable number will be joining the program.

8. Operations

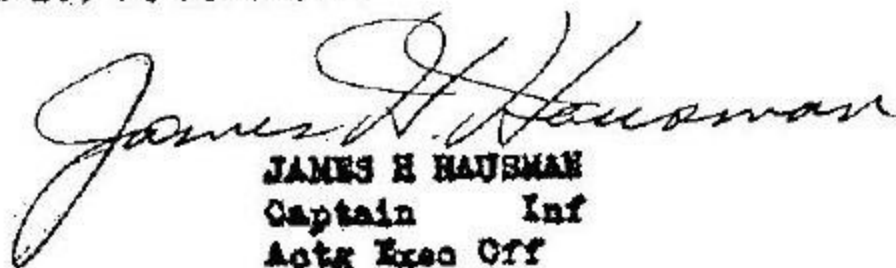
f. Cheju Do: 88 guerrillas KIA; 27 POW. KA losses, 18 KIA and 4 MIA. 2 LMG, 9 M-1 and 8 Carb recovered.

11. Korean Navy: Intensified patrol of Cheju Do ordered. 4 vessels now on patrol around island.

Efforts to refloat the YMS #511, which foundered on a rock in Kymon Do Harbor, unsuccessful.

Translation and prtg of lat two pts of EN Bluejackets' Manual completed and distributed.

Navy vessel used to transport relief supplies to Cheju Do. Main items consisted of shoes, 1800 yd cloth, 60 boxes multi-purpose food (70 lbs ea box) and 100 lb medicine.

6. Operations:

In order to present a more condensed report, operations in the future will be reported in three major areas: 38th parallel, SK and Cheju Do.

a. 38th parallel: 5 incidents reported during period, with fol results:

Enemy: KIA, 18; MIA, MIA and POW, 0.
KA : KIA, 1; MIA, 1; MIA and POW, 0.

b. South Korea: Casualties arising from incidents rptd as fol:

Guerrillas: KIA, 113; MIA and MIA, 0; POW, 26
KA : KIA, 116; MIA, 15; MIA and POW, 0

c. Cheju Do: 3 incidents reported, with fol results:

Guerrillas: KIA, 3; WIA and MIA, 0; POW 279.
KA : KIA, WIA, MIA and POW, 0.

KOREAN NAVY

1. Four vessels commenced moving KA troops 21 Km to the small islands located near and off Cheju Do for purpose of cleaning up guerrillas that may have taken refuge there.

2. 4 vessels presently patrolling shores of Cheju Do.
No smugglers reported during period.

(3) On Cheju Do it is estimated that only two (2) unimportant communist leaders remain. Guerrilla operations are poorly organized, captured guerrillas show an intense desire to quit the cause and be peaceful citizens. Local American Advisors state, "We can see an end in the immediate future to organized guerrilla warfare"
