

1. Platoon demonstrations by the 5th RCT held at Taejon and Kwangju for the 2nd and 5th Brigs. Demonstration platoon departs for Cheju Do 19 April to run demonstrations for units of 2nd Regt and the one (1) Special Bn. Co demonstrations will be held at Uijongbu 28 April for units of 7th Brig; 2 May for units of 1st Brig; and 5 May for key personnel representing the remaining four (4) Brigs.

3. Conference between Minister of National Defense and Chief, KMAG was held 16 April. Present also were Chief of Staff, KMAG and Advisor to Korean Army. Matters discussed and agreed upon follow:

a. Withdrawal of certain Korean troops from Cheju Do (see opns)

b. Eventual removal from Cheju Do of all present or former Northwest Youth members is planned. Will include evacuation from Army, Police and Civilian ranks. Knowledge gained from experience in the past confirms idea that NW Youth behavior is responsible for enmity existing between inhabitants of Cheju and the NW Youth.

6. Operations:

c. Cheju Do: 6 incidents reported during period with following results:

Enemy: KIA 93; WIA 0; POW 321; MIA 0

KA: KIA 0; WIA 0; POW 0; MIA 0

d. Operations in general:

(1) Recent opns on Cheju Do definitely point to a complete disintegration of guerrilla forces on the island. It has been decided to terminate major operations and to commence immediately to withdraw trps back to mainland. One Bn will be ordered back by 1 May; if progress continues, addtl trps will be withdrawn. It is hoped that eventually only one Bn, composed mainly of native troops, will remain on Cheju.

c. Cheju Do: 8 incidents reported during period with following results: Enemy KIA 66; WIA and MIA 0; POW 628.
KA: KIA 0; WIA, POW and MIA 0.

d. Opns in general:

Increase in incidents along 38th parallel noted - (5 incidents preceding wk; 12 incidents current report). In view of the fact, SK forces suffered no casualties, the increase not considered serious.

Opns on Cheju Do suspended from 0800 26 Apr to 1800 29 Apr. During this period, 40 POWs were permitted to return to mountains to request remaining guerrillas to lay down arms and surrender. Results of this action unknown at this time. On 24 Apr, 1310 POWs were screened, oriented, permitted to return home. 1 Bn of 2nd Regt now under orders to move to mainland where they will billet at Kwangju. Situation on Cheju Do will be watched very closely and as dictated by situation, addtl trps will be ret'd to mainland until one Bn remains.
