In Cheju a mob of fifty persons attacked the grain collecting committee beating them with sticks. The Police made three arrests following the incident and are continuing investigation.

POLICE: When one policeman began tearing down leftist handbills on Cheju Island, he was attacked. Other policemen were called to the scene and began tearing down all the handbills posted. A mob then gathered and attacked and chased the Police who fired their rifles in order to slow down their pursuers. Certain members of the mob also possessed weapons which they fired at the Police. Police soon had the situation in hand. Six of the mob were injured.

b. Terrorism

Cheju reports that members of the Dai Dong Chung Nyun Dang have been holding meetings for recruiting and propagandizing purposes which have resulted in reports of terrorism from four separate villages. The chairman of the Democratic Peoples Front reported five cases of beatings

rendered by subject group. Three of the names given belonged to persons who could not be contacted because of the harvesting season. One man contacted stated that he had been beaten while the other denied same. Investigation continues.

NORTHWEST YOUNG MEN'S ASSOCIATION - Taegu and Incheon CIC report that the local branch of NWYMA has reorganized. This reorganization was accomplished by members who either resigned their membership in UYMP or who had refused to join UYMP originally. The Seoul Hq of NWYMA has repeatedly stated that no branches of NWYMA were authorized to merge into UYMP, but several branches have merged. The word is probably getting around and those who have formally merged will probably be reorganized under the colors of NWYMA and continue operation along their established lines.

SAW BOOK recently dispatched a mission to Cheju-do for the purpose of organizing a branch of the association. They (SAW BOOK) are also conducting a public opinion poll and generally enlightening the islanders who inhabit the small islands off KOKPO. (KOKPO police reports that the visitors have been well received and the people of one Myun and Gun "donated" 50,000 yen to the cause of NWYMA).
