SUBJECT: DEMOCRATIC PEOPLE'S FRONT, Anti-American and Anti-IG activities of,

MARCH

1 March - Officials of the Democratic Peoples Front lead riot in CHEJU DO. Attempt to attack Dist Police station and Inspection Command Bldg. Hold parade and a demonstration in defiance of IG orders, throw rocks at the police and Americans, forcing the police to fire upon them, killing six and wounding 4. (8-171-60).

10 March - Confiscated documents issued by the SKLP to the CHEJU DO Comm of the SKLP reveal the following instructions: "We cannot live even a day with an easy mind as long as the brutal police remain. Let us knock down our enemy". Another document from the Labor Section, Dept of Orgn, CHEJU DO Committee, SKLP, dated 16 Feb 47, addressed to "Every cell of factories," compares the famous SAE IL demonstration of 1911 with the October 1946 People's Insurrection; and condemns IG actions and states Gen Hodge's #2 and #72 Decrees causing the shooting and imprisoning of Korean People. III - ESPIONAGE SCHOOLS

4. According to a female espionage agent interrogated from 21 April to 27 April 1947; the International Communist Party is operating two espionage schools in North Korea. One is located in Haeju and the other near Sinuiju. Fifth columnists trained at these schools have been sent to South Korea in groups of fifty, led by three officers trained in the USSR. The first group to be sent to South Korea started about 01 March 1947 and took a week to cross the 38th parallel. She reported that some of the graduates of these schools have established a Communist terrorist training center on the island of CHEJU DO. (CIC File 14-00-100 S).

SUBJECT: South Korea, Actual and Suspected Espionage Agents in

88. LEE, Su Han, newspaper reporter, Seoul People's Daily News, Cheju Do Branch, was investigated by Cheju Do CIC for possible espionage activities. Original lead came from the leader of the Cheju Do Branch of the North West Young Men's Association. Investigation revealed nothing to substantiate the allegation that LEE, Su Han was an extreme Leftist who joined the Korean National Youth Corps for the purpose of gathering information on that organization for the South Korea Labor Party. E.) Other Subversive Activity of the South Korea Labor Party:

5. On 17 May 48, a confidential informant of the Cheju CIC Office gave the following information which are instructions being issued to staff members of the SKLP in Cholla Pukto Province for week beginning 17 May 48:

Even though the SKLP fought well in other cities and provinces in South Korea during the election period, there were no disturbances in this province. The reasons for this were that the SKLP in Cholla Pukto spent its power in the disturbances during the month of February, and since that time, staff members have not trained the ones under them well enough. Staff members must begin now to train the members under them well, so that they may be more successful next time. The first phase of the training, as usual, will consist of agitation and propaganda. The members must be taught that the Americans will not withdraw from South Korea, even though the Russians withdraw from North Korea, because the United States wants property and minerals from South Korea. First the South Korea Labor Party will agitate for the withdrawal of American troops. The people in Cholla Pukto must do as well as the people on Cheju have done. (B-2)

V. SOCIAL, CIVIL AND LABOR CONDITIONS:

A. Civil Disturbances, Information Concerning the People's Guerilla Forces on Cheju-Do:

The information in this report was obtained from two raiders who were apprehended at different points on Cheju-Do. The information substantiates the report that the raiders are well organized and possess weapons, however, no indication that arms or men are arriving from North Korea, as had previously been reported, has been uncovered.
