

cases complete destruction of balloting places, particularly in North Cheju. In some cases almost the entire village population either left voluntarily or by force on Election Day.]

Despite a vigorous campaign by the Communists, excellent comparative results were obtained. In the three electoral districts in Cheju (2 in North and 1 in South Cheju) a total of 69.8% were registered and 86.6 of actual registrants voted. (Inclosure No. 55). In North Cheju the voting was higher, however, than in any other area in South Korea:

In view of the situation prevailing on Cheju, the Military Governor, on recommendation of the National Election Committee, invalidated the voting in the two electoral districts of North Cheju. Elections in these areas were postponed indefinitely. (See Inclosure No. 46 for detailed report of U.S. observers).

25 Apr	Cheju Do	For the period ending noon this date the following riots and disturbances have been reported: 1. All telephone lines east of Cheju Do city to Sogwipo were cut. 2. A C-47 plane, taking off from Cheju Do Air Strip, on the afternoon of 24 April was fired upon by two (2) snipers. 3. The PX Building in the Military Government area was broken into during the night. 4. Three Rightist civilians were shot to death by raiders in the village of Siman-Ni.

1. There is attached for your information a list of sixteen (16) Committee Chairmen, Members, and Committee Personnel who have been killed and wounded since 6 April 1948.

2. Most of these incidents have been included in tabulations previously furnished you, but it was thought advisable to isolate from these lists the members of the
