We expect no trouble from raiders but there is always the danger one of our men may become involved if he happened to be at the right time. We have increased the guard around the post and have a telephone check every half hour. Practice alert scheduled for tomorrow morning.

14 August (Saturday) Inspections and usual guard duties. Inspection of men and barracks at 0900 was very good. Have been stressing the fact that all men should try for promotions and most of the men are doing their best. Promoted Private Sanchez. Inspected Mess at 1000 and Motor Pool at 1030. Practice alert at 1100. We have a pretty fair cordon defense set up for the camp. Had short TIF and VD lecture and then issued Red Cross items to all men. Allowed men to go to the show but we made them take it very slow coming back. All men were back in camp at 2140. About 2150 we saw a series of signal fires up in the mountains. Everyone got ready to move out by drawing ammo and weapons. We cancelled the Bingo game but went ahead with the lunch and went to bed when nothing happened. I stayed awake a good part of the night and didn't even hear a gun go off. It was a clear moonlit night. Now the police are talking about some trouble coming on the 23rd of this month.
