4. Representative Character of Assembly Members:

Eight persons, some for political reasons, including the famous leftist, Iyuh hoon Kyung, refused to take their seats. The representatives of Cheju (small island off the southwest tip of Korea), have never appeared to register their memberships. They are reported to have been waylaid by leftists on arriving in Seoul and discouraged from participating in the work of the assembly. New appointments for Cheju were recently made.

2. Subversive Activity

(4) Political Groups Clash in Southern Korea:

CHEJU ISLAND

The third incident of consequence occurred on Cheju Island when a large crowd marched on a police station. Police fired into the crowd killing six persons. One policeman was injured.

(5) General Strike Breaks Out: Information received from National Police on 13 March 1947 stated that the following report had been received from Cheju Island (Saishu To): "Sixty-four policemen have resigned since the 1 March incident. Demonstration made by all the middle school students in the city (Cheju). Business stops as employees strike". Telephone reports from Pusan CIC on 14 March 1947 stated that all Military Government employees with the exception of the police and court officials had gone on strike

on the island. Police reinforcements from Cholla Nampo and Cholla Pukto were dispatched.

The general strike on Cheju was prompted by the 1 March 1947 incident. The public made several protests to the police and Military Government Officials over police brutality, and finally staged the over-all strike as a protest.

The Seoul Han Sung Ilbo, moderate right-wing newspaper, stated on 13 March 1947 in an article regarding the Cheju situation that 90% of the population of Cheju is left-wing.

(1) South Korea General Strike 22 March 1947: Rightist terrorism, leftist propaganda against the police, plus the usual labor demands
