On Cheju Do constabulary action has resulted in the death of 51 raiders. (PMAQ report).

Comment: Credit for successful sorties against the guerrillas may be given villagers who are assisting the authorities by giving information concerning guerrilla locations and plans. Recent guerrilla attacks and burning of homes have aroused civilian antagonism toward the raiders in many locales.

8. The following restriction have been imposed on Cheju Do by Korean officials as a result of Communist activity: all fishing boats have been restricted since 20 October to prevent traffic to the Yosu area; and, on 09 November, all middle schools were closed pending loyalty checks on teachers and students.

2. Raiders continued to be active on Cheju Do and to be rounded up by the constabulary. During this period it was reported that 2 towns were attacked, 50 Rightists killed, 30 Communists killed and a delayed summary for the period 11-26 Nov lists a total of 167 Communists killed.

5. Communist violence, including all reports except those for Yosu, Taegu, Naju and Kangwon Do, total 2 attacks on towns, 1 attack on police, 50 Rightist killed, 30 Communists killed (all on Cheju Do), 3 attacks on Rightist, 2 acts of sabotage, 2 labor strikes and 1 school strike. Delayed reports list 167 Communists killed, and 2 attacks on Rightist. No Rightist-inspired acts of violence were reported. Three individuals were attacked by persons of unknown political affiliation during the period and a delayed report lists 1 such attack on 18 Nov.
