1. The following report covers period 1800, 8 October, 1948 to 1800, 9 October, 1948.

- (a) K.C.G.C. TAN CHUN : According to the reports of Che Ju Do. (Oct 9, 9:00) One submarine Boat of unknown nationality appeared upon the sea of about Eight Mile of Che Ju Do, But when they discovered the boat she was hidden at Once. The time was on Oct 8, 12:20.
- (b) K.C.G.C. KIM HAE was on patrolling round South Coast of Che Ju Do Island. When found 2 sailing Boats. Those Boats were legal.
