Following UNCOK developments have taken place since MYTEL 401 April 16.

(1) Chinese Delegate Liu departed for Canton, Hong Kong, April 16. Expected return May 2. Philippine Delegate Luna departed Manila April 23. Expected return May 2.

(2) French Delegate resigned as Chairman Subcommittee two in protest indefinite postponement UNCOK visit Chejudo which canceled due weather conditions (paragraph 5 OURTEL 401 April 16. Rhee informally invited UNCOK view May 10 elections Chejudo. UNCOK party leaving visit Cholla Namdo April 25.

(3) Subcommittee one heard Kim Kiu Sic April 22.

(4) Full Commission met April 22. Secretariat severely criticized by Luna.


