

On May 10, 1949, the last two regular elections in the National Assembly were held in the two northern districts of the island of Cheju. These districts were the original elections, exactly a year before the disturbances. Their occurrence was a direct result of the control which the military government has at last achieved and the chaos during which approximately 300,000 people were killed. The Government issued orders for the election to be held and the 95% of the votes registered in District 1 and District 2 were registered in District 1 and District 2.

The elected members were one woman, a girl's middle school teacher, and a member of the National Society, and Hwang Gwang Guk, a Korea Youth Corps member and a native of Cheju.

With the election of these two members to the present National Assembly is, for the first time, ties binding traditionally isolated and remote to the mainland. These two members are...
