On the night of 30 April power and telephone lines were cut between SOGUI PO (957-1119) and MOSULPO (923-1116). (Police rpt)

✓ a. Communists Attack Villages On CHEJU DO

(1) At 031700 May approximately 100 communists attacked the town of AEWOL (930-1147). Police dispatched reinforcements from CHEJU city.. (Police rpt)

(2) At 031930 May a mob of 60, 20 of whom were armed with rifles, attacked the village of HWEDO RI (948-1152). (Police rpt)

✓ b. Election Officials Evacuate Homes On CHEJU DO

As a result of terroristic activities voting district committeemen who live between the mountains and the main island highway are leaving their homes and believed to be living in coastal towns. No alternates or replacements can be secured. (Police rpt)

✓ a. Latest Reports of CHEJU DO Riots

(1) Approximately fifty (50) raiders attacked the town of NAM DOK (91155) on 04 May, kidnapping two DAI DONG YOUTH members. (Police report)

(2) On 04 May dynamite was thrown into a police box at MOSULPO (924-1117), but failed to explode. (Police report)

(3) At 041300 May police line repairmen working near the village of TO TO RI (947-1151) were fired on from an inland ridge. Police returned the fire and one sniper was wounded and captured. (Police report)

(4) At 050100 the village of HUIBOK (957-1152) was raided, resulting in the death of two men and one woman and the wounding of one man. One of the men killed was a voting district chairman. The strength of the attackers was undetermined as they operated in groups of three to five masked. (CIC P/R #107 A-1)

(5) The village of SAM YANG (958-1153) was raided on 050200 May. Two DAI DONG YOUTH members were killed. As in the attack on HUIBOK (para 4 above) attackers operated in groups of three to five. (CIC P/R #107 B-2)

✓ a. Police Box Attacked in CHEJU DO

At 060330 May 48 raiders attacked a police sub-station at HUL RUMON (923-1116). Police repelled the attack killing one of the rioters. The attackers abandoned five rounds of American carbine ammunition, 90 rounds of Japanese rifle ammunition, one Japanese sword and eight bottles of gasoline. (Police rpt)
